

Jennie Starbuck - Decorated rimmed platters - October 16th 2002

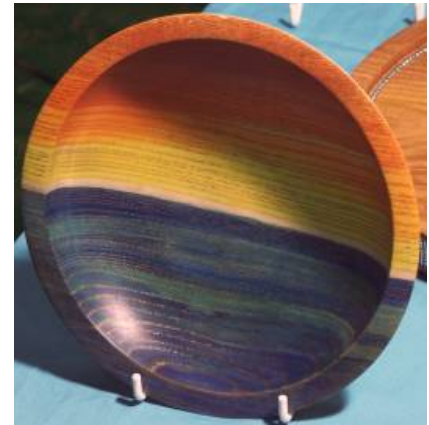

For our October 2002 programme some 50 members and visitors from the East Surrey Woodturning Club watched Jennie Starbuck commence her interesting and entertaining programme by explaining how she and her husband came to start woodturning and how she had progressed to decorating her turned work



Jennie then demonstrated by turning a blank piece of ash and turning this in her own technique for beads and inlays, with the end result a decorated bowl.

Jennie then explained and showed different methods of colouring and materials that she used and had some examples of her coloured work on display.



From my point of view being a relatively inexperienced woodturner this proved to be a very interesting and informative angle to turning and without doubt something to try in the future.
